




CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING

LANDSCAPING: The crews have completed the over seeding on Meridiana Parkway. In addition, they have completed the weed control application in the flower bed and tree wells. There has been a reduction in plant growth due to the cooler temperatures, however this has allowed the crews to focus on detail trimming.

GATES: Please let us know if you are experiencing any key fob, EZ tag, pedestrian gate code or vehicle gate code issues. You can visit Courtney Fisher at the Welcome Center from 7am to 4pm Monday-Thursday with any concerns.

LAKES & FOUNTAINS: Please continue to report any lake/fountain issues to us that you may see in the community. Remember to always use caution around the lakes. November treatment of algae in the lakes did prove to be successful. Floating Bridge Park fountains have been installed as well.

LIGHTING & ELECTRICAL: 1) New conservatory fans have been ordered and will be installed next month. 2) the entrance screen has been repaired and we are awaiting parts for the Meridian Tower at the Oasis Village.

MAINTENANCE: We have our maintenance man working on pressure washing all around the Oasis Village, and cleaning the building windows. He also visited all the parks in the community to ensure trash was picked up and everything was in working order.

MISCELLANEOUS: 1) Reminder: If you see any vandalism in the community, please report it to the Police Department immediately at 281-369-3444 or 281-756-2392. If you notice damage that has already occurred to any portion of the common areas, please report it to the HOA immediately. 2) The new palm trees in the family pool have been installed. 3) New paddle boards have been purchased for the Oasis Village. 4) The hammocks around the Welcome Center have been replaced. Please handle these with care.

2022 ASSESSMENT: We are very pleased to announce that the 2022 Assessment will remain at \$1,050. The assessment statements will be mailed this month. Assessments are due January 1st and late after January 31st. To make you aware of the timelines, Final Reminders will be sent on February 1st and any account not paid or on a payment plan by March 3rd, will be turned over to the attorney for collection. If you are a new homeowner and not sure if your assessments were paid at closing, please ask. We will help and answer any questions you may have.


MERIDIANA HOSTS RETURN OF NIGHTLY SYNCHRONIZED DRIVE-THRU HOLIDAY LIGHTS EXPERIENCE

Meridiana, the award-winning community of new homes minutes south of Pearland, is celebrating the holiday season with the return of its drive-thru experience featuring thousands of twinkle lights along Meridiana Parkway performing nightly to the sounds of the season.

Meridiana Musical Lights is open daily beginning at dusk, starting November 26 through New Years, with free admission. Upon arrival, families can set their car radios to 87.9 FM and enjoy the two-mile round-trip on the parkway watching the holiday lights dance to festive tunes.

During their drive-thru, families can stop in Meridiana's Welcome Center for complementary hot cocoa Tuesday – Thursday until 8 p.m. and its onsite Café Sol Friday and Saturday until 11 p.m. for complimentary coffee, hot cocoa and delicious holiday treats. Both are located in the community's Oasis Village, 4003 Meridiana Parkway, at the midway point of the drive-thru holiday lights experience.

To reach Meridiana Musical Lights, take the Meridiana Parkway exit from Texas 288 in either direction. Heading south on Texas 288, take the Meridiana Parkway exit 3.5 miles south of Highway 6 and turn left onto the overpass. Those heading north on Texas 288 can take the Meridiana Parkway exit and turn right into the community.
