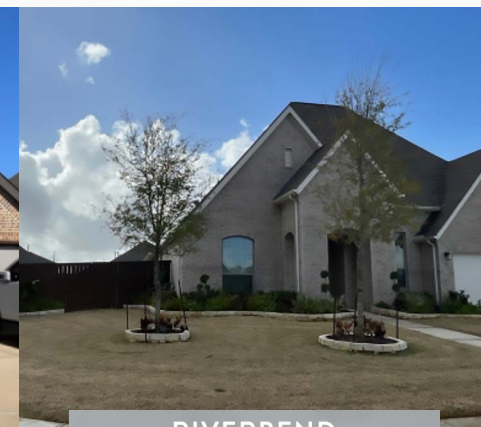

FOLLOWING RECORD-SETTING SALES YEAR MERIDIANA MAINTAINS RANKING AMONG NATION'S TOP-SELLING COMMUNITIES

With close to 500 new homes sold in 2023, the Texas 288 community of Meridiana set a single-year sales record while maintaining its status on the recently released ranking of the nation's 50 top-selling master-planned communities.

Meridiana's 497 new home sales last year rank the community at #37 among the nation's top sellers as compiled by RCLCO Real Estate Consulting.

New home sales in the well-planned community of new homes minutes south of Pearland were up an impressive 24% compared to its 2022 figures. Meridiana also was the only master-planned community south of Houston to earn a spot on the prestigious list.

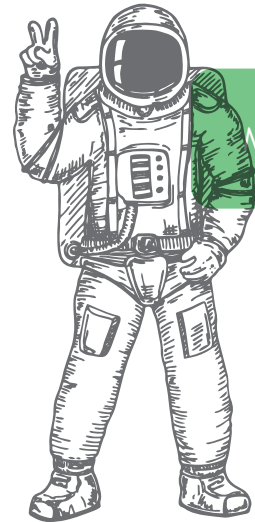
Each 4th of July holiday, the residents of Meridiana have a great view of the spectacular fireworks display at Freedom Stadium off on Iowa Colony Boulevard.

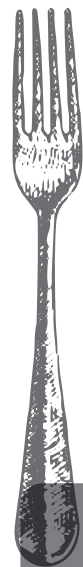

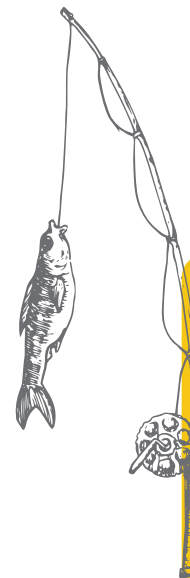

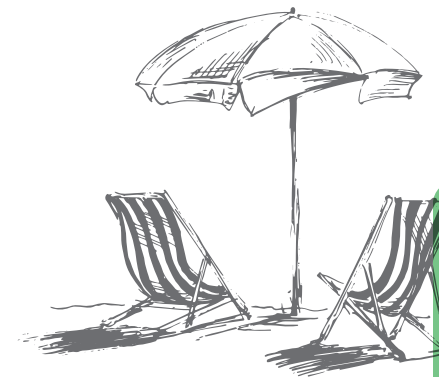
Café Sol - food is very appetizing and there is always a weekly special.

With its proximity to Mustang Bayou, Meridiana provides a canoe launch for residents to explore the waterways.

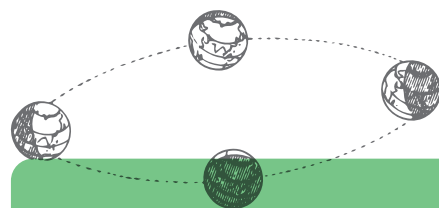
This unique feature adds a recreational dimension to the community, catering to those who enjoy water activities.

The name Meridiana is derived from the meridian, an imaginary longitudinal line that circles the earth from one pole to another and back.



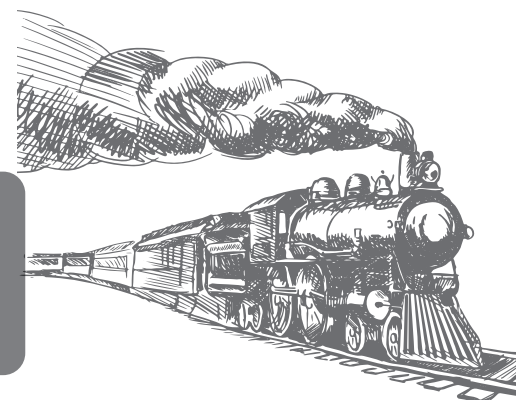
Meridiana runs a Community Ambassador Program where experienced residents, known as ambassadors, help newcomers integrate into the community.
